We are obligated to give Sco all information, contracts, assets etc. pertaining to the UnixWare business and the old UNIX source code business. They have bought it lock, stock and barrel. Once the transaction is closed (Nov.-Dec.) we will have no more involvement with this business. Therefore, if a contract is for UnixWare or UNIX, it will be SCO's. If a contract is for UnixWare and lets say NetWare, the UnixWare part is theirs. Since we do not want to disclose our NetWare deal's T's and C's, we are looking into whether or not we give them a copy of the agreement with the words pertaining to NetWare blacked out, or just provide them a synopsis of the terms and conditions. Hopefully we will have an answer soon. In the mean time, providing them any and all information on the UnixWare or UNIX deals is the right thing to do.
