As you may know, NOVELL transferred to The Santa Cruz Operation, Inc. ("SCO") its existing ownership interest in UNIX® System-based software and related products, including UnixWare® offerings.

The subject Agreement defined NOVELL's and X/OPEN's respective roles and responsibilities concerning conformance branding of such UnixWare offerings.. It makes immeasurably more business sense for SCO, as the owner of such offerings, to administer conformance of both the UnixWare product line and SCO's Open Server® product line under a common contractual relationship.

In furtherance to this objective, NOVELL would like X/OPEN's formal concurrence, under Section 11 of the subject Agreement, to NOVELL's assignment of its rights and delegation of any remaining obligations to SCO.
