SCO office Server Overview



- Delivers a reliable, full-featured Internet e-mail solution
- Prevents e-mail viruses, filters out junk e-mail, and secures remote access
- Delivers a real-time Internet collaboration solution
- Integrates with Outlook[®], e-mail readers, and Web browsers
- Features a friendly interface for non-technical admins.



Customer Problems Solved



- Susceptible to e-mail viruses that may cripple business

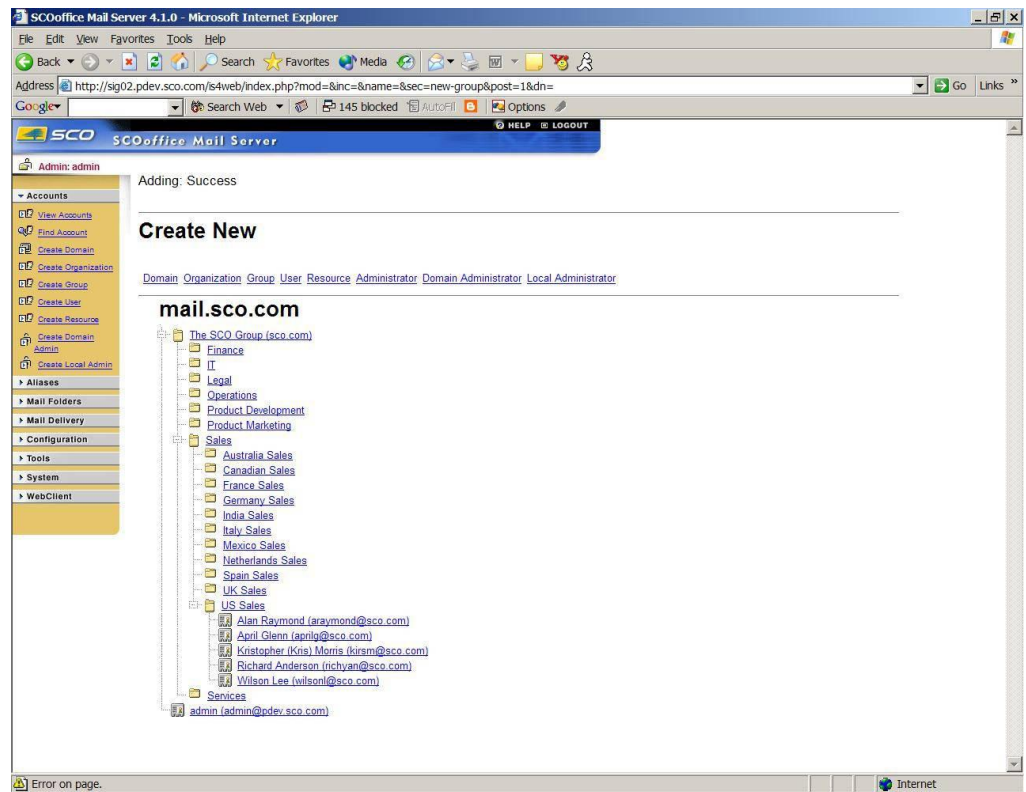

- Interface similar to Microsoft Outlook.





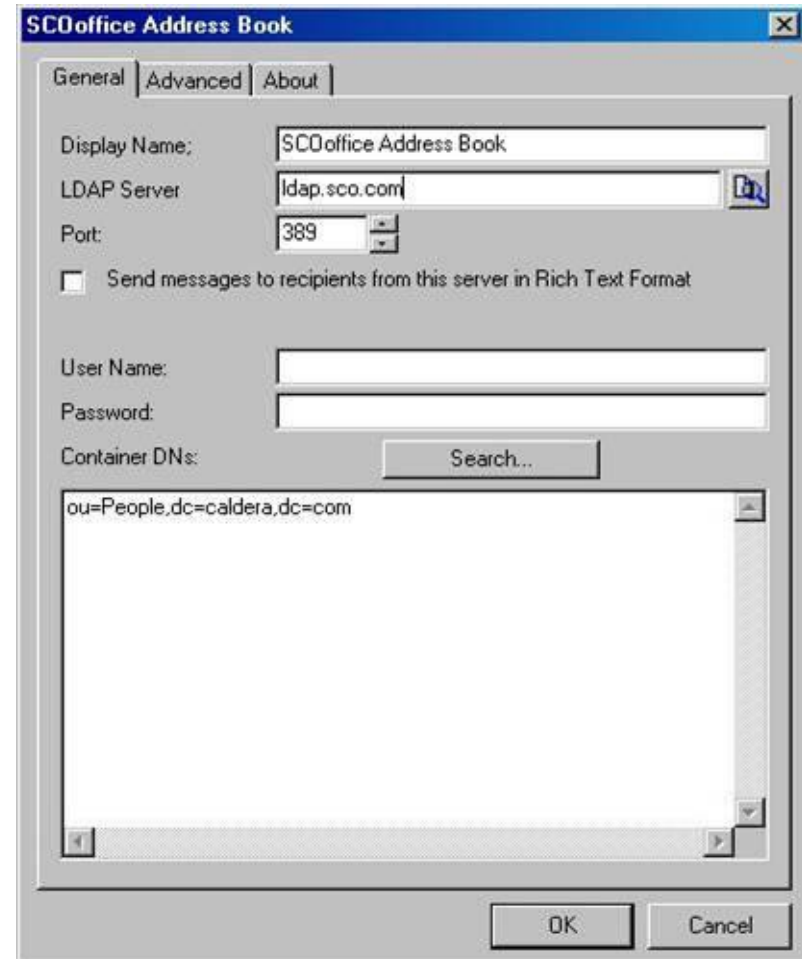

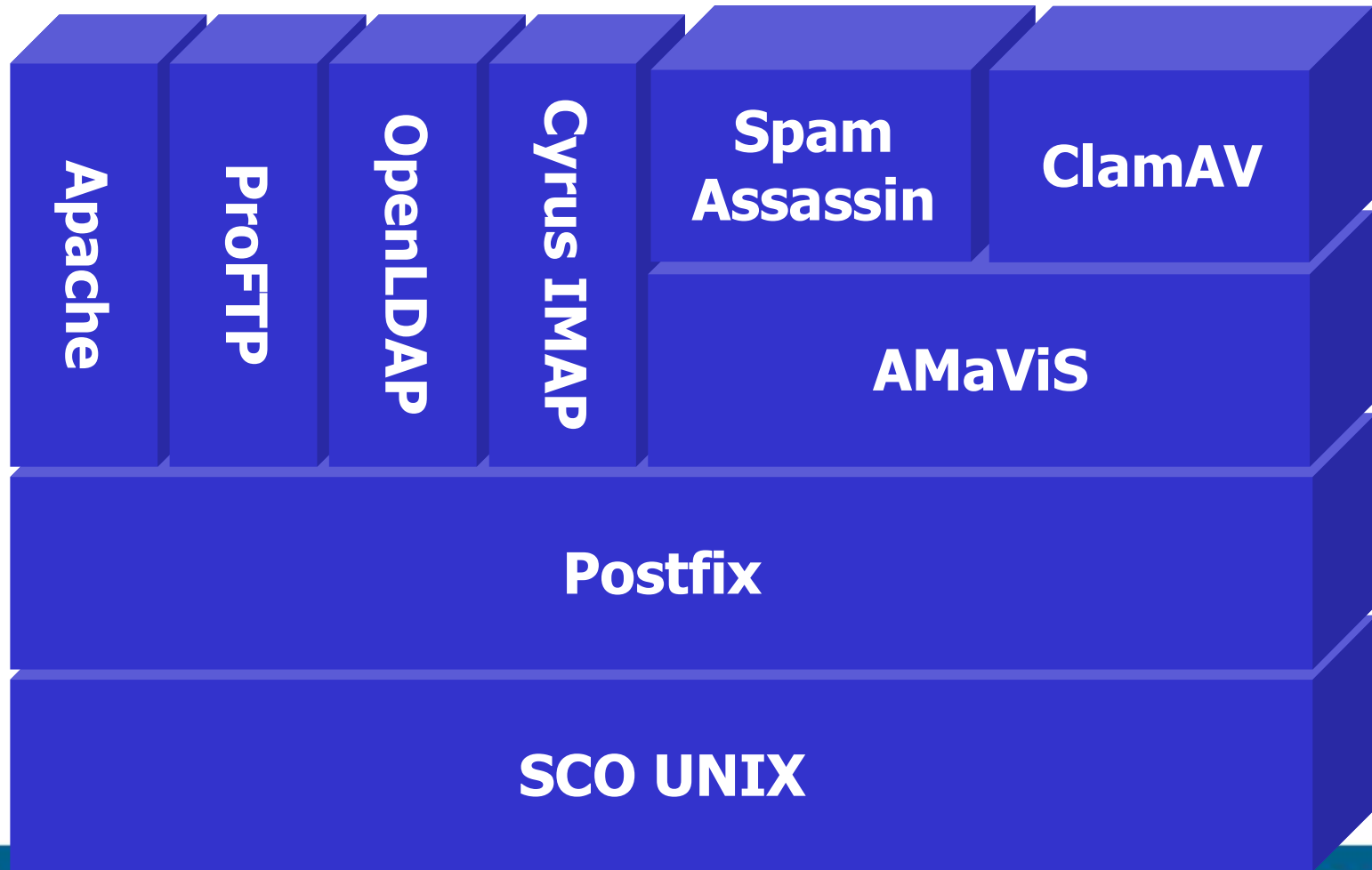

Overview - SCO office Architecture

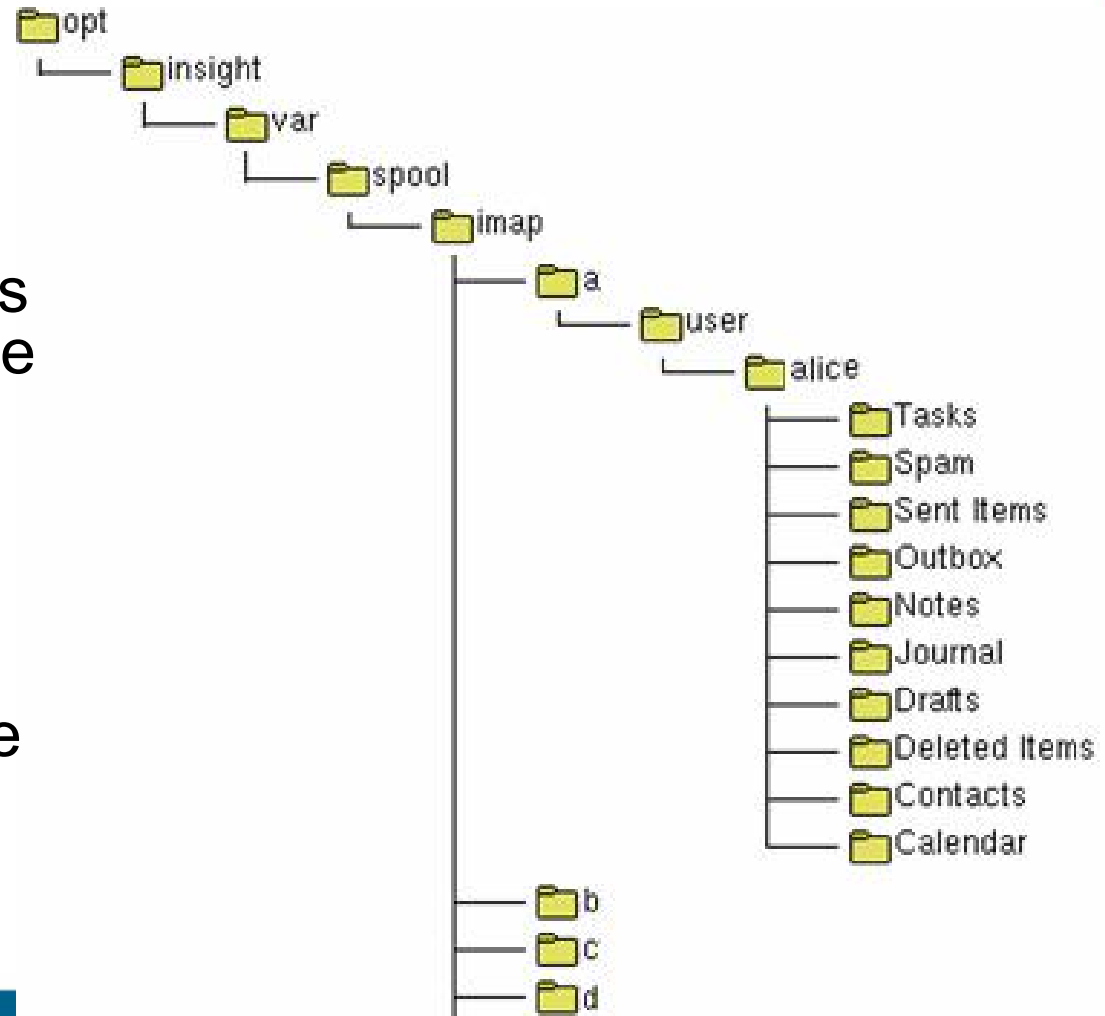


Location of Mail Folders in Filesystem



















Advantages

- Each email message is stored as a separate file
- If one file becomes corrupted, the whole data store is not corrupted
- Easy to restore a single email message
- Can rebuild a single users inbox

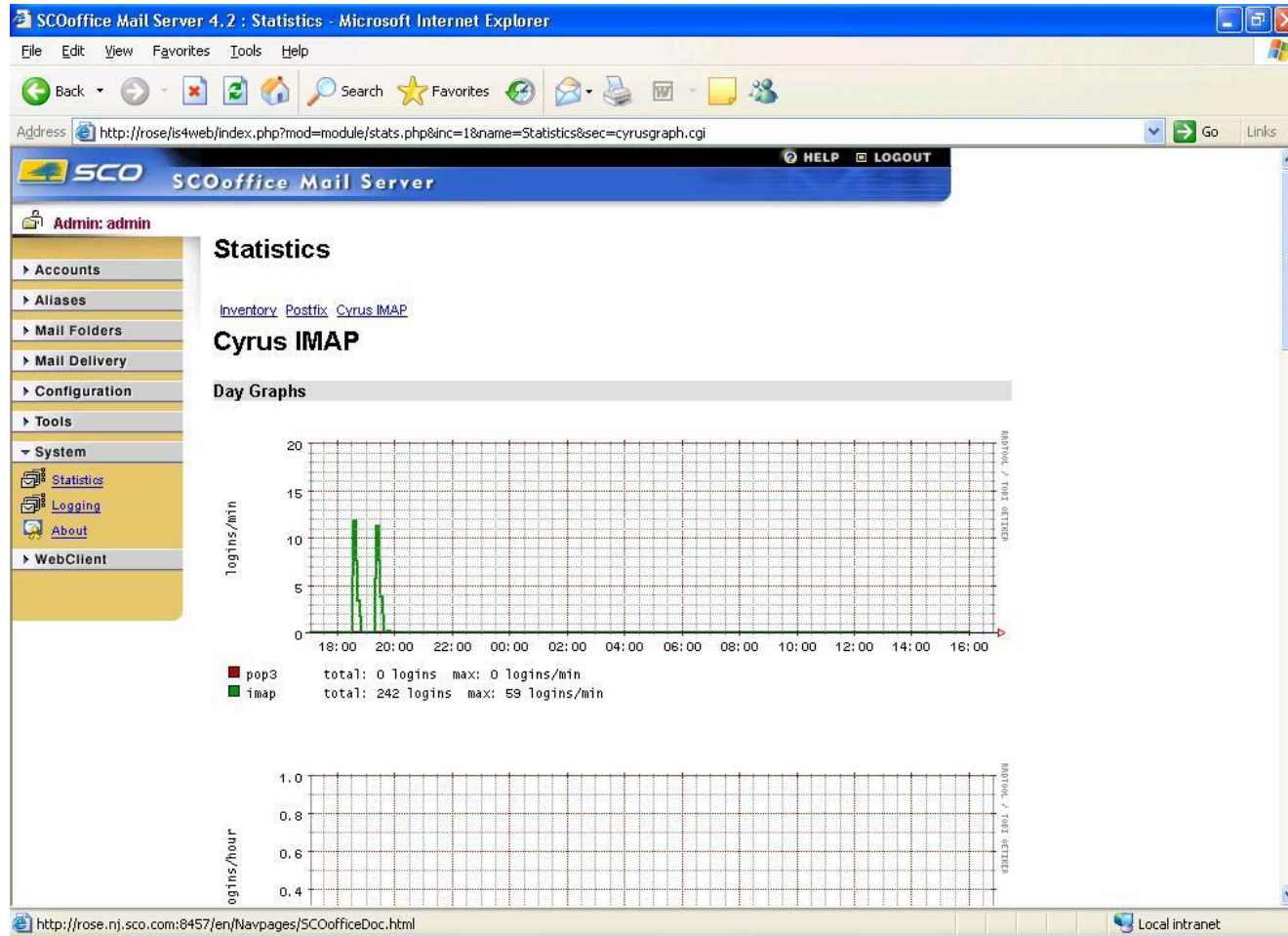
