Full SCO support for AFPS will continue to be offered through **30 April 2008**. Existing customers will receive standard support through the expiration dates of their support contracts up to 30 April 2008. Effective 1 May 2007, only limited Retired Product support will be available for purchase for this product for any new and renewing customers.
