The Apache 2 Supplement provides a custom installable Apache 2 Web Server for OpenServer 6.0.0. It will co-exist with Apache 1.3.37 which was included with Maintenance Pack 3. With the co-existence support customers will be able to continue running the older version while migrating existing web pages and applications to the new release.
