1 Product Description

Effective 1 February 2008 SCO is eliminating the need for additional CPU and CPU Trade-In licenses for all OpenServer 6 and UnixWare 7.1.4 systems and will remove the associated model numbers from the price list. To accomplish this, SCO will be posting updates for both operating systems on its download site. With the installation of the update, systems will no longer require additional CPU licenses and the operating systems will then support up to 32 logical CPUs, i.e. 32 single, 16 dual or 8 quad core.

2 Availability

Current OpenServer 6 and UnixWare 7.1.4 customers will be able to download the updates by 11 February at no charge. The updates along with installation instructions can be found on the SCO Download site as follows:
