

April System Design AniTA Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Does your solution require any additional tools or skills to develop? If so, what?

A: General understanding of Windows.

Q: On average, what timeframe would be required for a new customer to come up to speed on using your solution?

A: After converting a few screens to AniTa the customer should be up to speed.

Q: On average, once a customer is up to speed on using your solution, on average, how much time could be spent on converting a single “green screen” into a Windows look and feel?

A: Depending on the complexity of the screen from 15 minutes to a couple of hours.

Q: Does the customer have to have access to the source code for their application?

A: No.

Q: Does any work need to be done to their source code to use your solution?

A: No, but additional enhancements could be done with access to the source code. AniTa can also be activated from the host side.

Q: What are the system requirements for a customer to use your solution?

A: Computer, Windows and AniTa.

Q: With your solution, can some users be using the Windows look and feel, while other users are using the old green screen look and feel?

A: Yes
